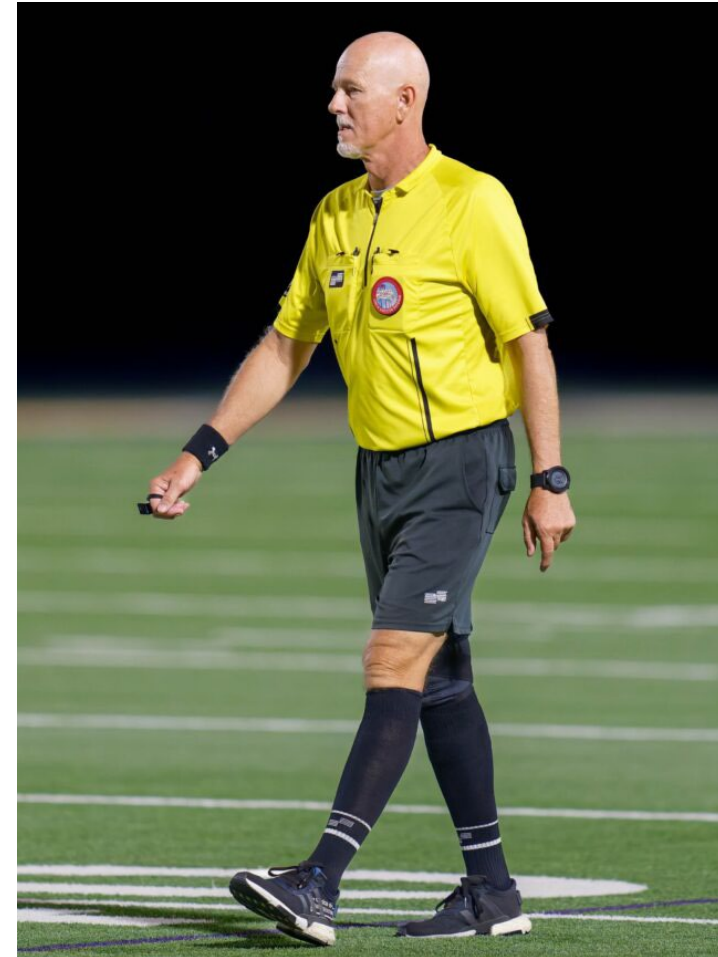
Season Fitness Preparation

Uniform Requirements

- Current USSF
 - Shirt

- Current Nevada Patch

- *DO NOT get undressed in public area.*



Fitness Test

- Passing the fitness test qualifies individual to be eligible and considered for either varsity center assignments.
- If you have not passed or not taken the test, *there will be a mid season test sometime in late September or early October*
- If you took but did not pass the test, you can be considered for a varsity center when there are not enough eligible officials available.
 - *Ranking will be done based upon the number of laps you completed.*

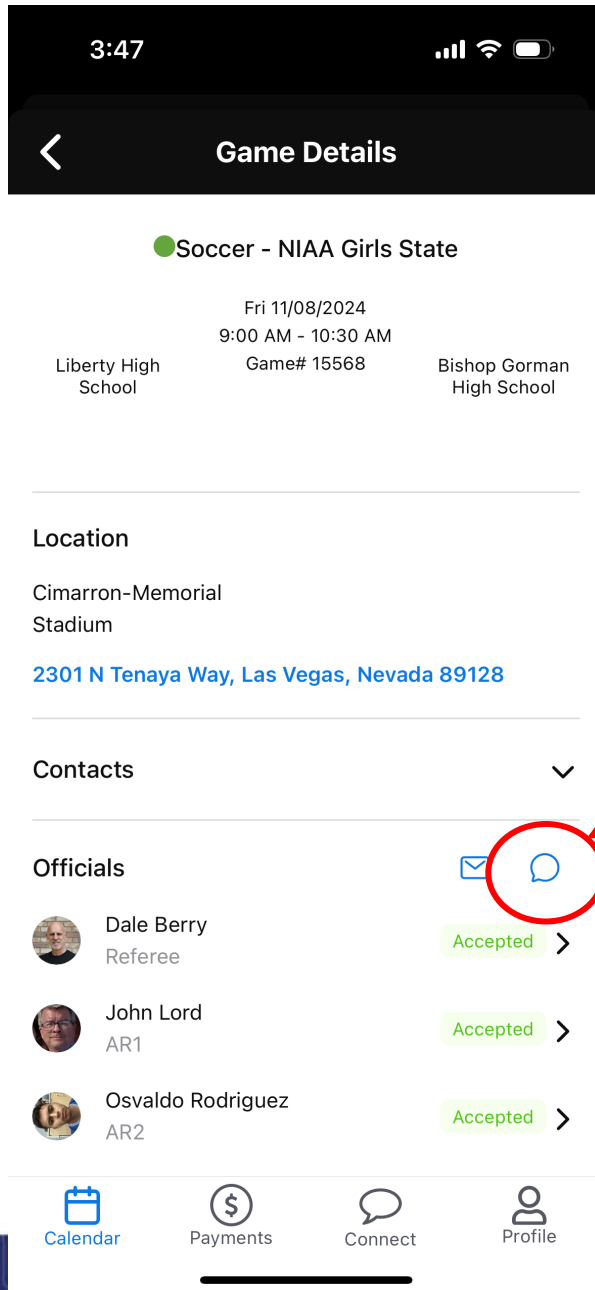

Coaches and Captains

- No Game Roster....No Game
- Coaches, are your players legally equipped.
 - They must verbally say “YES”
- Captains
 - Inform captains that the are the ONLY ONES allowed to talk to the referee
 - Visiting team calls the toss...
 - Nevada or Las Vegas (*not heads or tails*)



Managing Heat & Weather

Water breaks are mandatory until further notice (we do not add time for the JV games)

We add time for water breaks for the varsity games

Lighting delays (ten miles and 30 minutes)

Wet bulb thermometer available at Amazon (\$29)



Signs of Passing Out Due To Heat

- Fainting: A brief loss of consciousness.
- Dizziness: Feeling unsteady or like the room is spinning.
- Light-headedness: Feeling faint when rising from a chair or bed.
- Skin changes: Pale, cool, or clammy/moist skin.
- Weakness: Feeling very tired or having a weak pulse.
- Visual issues: Tunnel vision or blurred vision

Keep an eye on one another...look for signs of Heat Fatigue

Game Standards

- Enforce all rules the correct way (even socks and shin guards)
- At games 30 minutes before your kick off
- Every coach for every game gets a coaches card with the crews information on it
- Test required to work 90% or higher to be considered for playoffs

Dealing with Teams, Coaches, Spectators

- **DO NOT** ask for phone number or social media contact of any coach, administrator, or player
 - If you received a request do not accept it and contact us
- NO one is allowed to be with the referee crew on the sideline
- Only people on the roster are allowed in the bench area.
- You **DO NOT** have the authority to tell a fan to leave.
 - If a fan needs to be removed, as the administrator or coach to do it.
 - If the fan does not leave...then the crew leaves.
 - DO NOT interact directly with fans
