

- The sale of the Hoke Ritchie property has been completed. A check in the amount of \$3,817 has been received from the United States Department of the Interior National Park Service.
- Summer is a busy time for Kimball Youth. Please pay close attention to the weekly bulletin for important dates and payment reminders for Lutheridge, Mission Trip, and Kimball Camp.
- The first week of Kimball Camp will be June 9 13. All deposits are due on Monday, May 26th. Final payment, for the first week, is due on Friday, June 6th. Deposits for week 2 of Kimball Camp are due Monday, June 2nd and Final payment is due Friday, June 13th. Any camper registrations, after the Deposit Due Dates, will need to pay in full at the time of registration.
- The new sign, on Main Street, is scheduled to be installed on May 28th.
- We continue to seek volunteers to assist with the nursery at both services. We need 1 volunteer from each service, each Sunday, to work with Abby in the nursery. If you would be willing to volunteer please contact, Ben Hesley, Hannah Wiethorn or Deacon Liz to sign-up.
- The Education Committee had a successful meeting this month to restructure the Children's Sunday School Program. Sunday School will be divided into 2 groups, Ages 4 First Grade and 2<sup>nd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> Grade. The Sunday School year will be divided into 3 Sessions, Fall (Sept 7<sup>th</sup> Nov 16th), Winter (Jan 11<sup>th</sup> February 22nd) and Spring (March 1st May 7th). The commitment would be for 2-3 Sundays each Session. Please prayerfully consider volunteering your time to support our children by either sitting in the nursery or assisting with Sunday School. - Our monthly General Funds Offering update -In April, in General Funds we collected \$45,674.00. Our monthly budget for 2025 is \$42,916.00. This is the first month in 2025 we have met budget in the General Fund. Year to date our General Fund income is \$14,290 below budget.
- Lastly, after our trial month of passing the offering plate, we cease passing the plate and will be going back to having the offering plate at the entrance to Sanctuary beginning the first Sunday of June.

#### KIMBALL MEMBER COMMISSIONED AS A LAY PREACHER

Tony Lippard of our congregation was commissioned as a Lay Preacher at the Opening Worship Service of the 2025 North Carolina Synod Assembly

held in Greensboro the last weekend of May. Tony has been a part of a two-year program to help provide parish leadership for the smaller Lutheran congregations in North Carolina, and in other Synods in the ELCA.

Tony has participated with his cohort from the North Carolina Synod and a group of students from the Virginia Synod for this Commissioning. In this time, he has studied Theology, Biblical Studies - focusing on both the Old and New Testaments, and Preaching. As a part of his preaching assignment, Tony was asked to prepare a sermon and preach at both our Services on a Sunday this winter, and to preach at one of our Lenten Services as well. He has been instructed by Professors from our Southern Seminary, Roanoke College (our Lutheran college in Virginia) and the Divinity School at Wake Forest University.

Tony, and his wife, Paula, will still be with us in worship, but he will also now be able to serve our smaller congregations in the NC Synod, who have not been able to call a full-time pastor. We rejoice with him at this wonderful time of growth and leadership, and will follow his progress with great interest, pride, and joy.

Tony has expressed his great appreciation to the members of Kimball Memorial - and to Pastor John and Deacon Liz – for their support during this time of study and preparation. As a sign of their affection and support, Kimball Memorial has presented Tony with a beautiful Alb and Cincture for him to use in his ministry. We are very proud of him!
