FROM THE PASTOR BEYOND OURSELVES THIS FALL

When the legendary Amos Alonzo Stagg was a student at Yale, he was so poor that for a time he lived on twenty-five cents a day. Even so, this small

 $\operatorname{man}-\operatorname{only}$ five feet six inches tall $-\operatorname{made}$ Walter Camp's first All-American Football Team.

This splendid athlete considered the ministry: he attended Divinity School at Yale but concluded that his calling was not to the parish, but rather to the training of America's Youth. He coached football until he was almost ninety years old!

While Stagg was head football coach at the University of Chicago (a powerhouse team in his day) a phenomenal event occurred. In a game with the University of Illinois an official sustained an injury, and Alonzo Stagg was asked by the **opposing** coach to step in to referee. This was not unlike asking an attorney to judge her own case, or a farmer to determine price support for his crops, or a parent to evaluate his or her own child's final exams. It was just that Stagg possessed such a strong character and undisputed integrity, that the rival coach trusted him implicitly to make impartial calls.

During the autumn, we will continue our walk with Jesus through the Gospel of St. Luke, and we will watch as Jesus puts His words into action. He heals, teaches, performs other miracles and, most of all, Jesus loves unconditionally. This is a good season to remember that we too are called to faithfulness — not just by what we say or think - but also by what we do! What's the old saying: "You can talk the talk, but can you walk the walk!?!"

Are there ministries that you can involve yourself in this autumn at Kimball Memorial -putting YOUR faith into action? Our work with Faith Formation, Samaritan's Table, our three Sunday Choirs, Sunday School, our Bible Study on Wednesday morning, helping with our ministry to Coltrane Life Center, assisting with worship, lay readers, communion preparation. Perhaps you'd volunteer to write cards to our assisted living residents or older members. Or could you serve the church as an office volunteer? And certainly, your presence at Sunday morning worship, Sunday morning bible studies, Youth and Children's Ministries and your financial gifts are needed and appreciated at any time, and for any cause. Whatever your interests, we certainly need your time, talent, and treasure.

It is always a good time to follow in the footsteps of Our Lord, moving beyond ourselves to the needs of others. Please feel free to call me this month if you need some guidance and direction in serving!


WELCOME NEW MEMBERS
