

ELECTRONIC GIVING OPTIONS

Kimball provides a number of different options for our congregation to electronically present their offerings to the church.

BILL PAY — Most banks today offer a bill payment service with recurring feature. Individuals can set up their offering as a bill, and a check will be issued from that account and mailed to Kimball.

TITHE.LY (through kimballchurch.org) — By going to our church website, individuals can present offerings through an electronic service provided by Tithe.ly. The offerings can be set up as a one-time event or as recurring. There is a charge for this service and the individual has the option of paying the charge, or the amount will be deducted from the offering when sent to Kimball. If you would like any more information about any of these options, or assistance in getting one of the options set up, please contact any member of the finance team, or the church office.

BLESSING BOX NEEDS



Kimball Preschool will begin their '24-'25 school year on September 3rd. Below is a list of supplies that are needed and used through out the year. If you would

like to help and donate any of these items, it would be greatly appreciated. It's an exciting year ahead with enrollment almost full and the addition of a 1 year old class.

- Play-doh
- Crayola crayons (24 count)
- Paper towels
- Hand soap (foaming)
- Baby wipes
- Rubber gloves
- Paper plates
- Glue sticks
- Shark Vac Mop disposable floor pads
- Shark Vac Mop cleaning solution
- Band aids

Currently, the pantry items we are in biggest need of are:



- 1. Canned chicken, tuna, and other canned meats (hash, chili, vienna sausages, etc.)
- 2. Peanut butter
- 3. Canned carrots, potatoes, and mixed vegetables
- 4. Cereal (whole grain and low sugar, if possible)
- 5. Any kind of canned beans (especially baked, black, chili, white, and kidney)
- 6. Any canned fruit (especially pears, pineapple and oranges)
- 7. Pasta, macaroni & cheese
- 8. Shelf-stable milk
- 9. Diapers, toilet paper and paper towels

As always, we especially seek low sodium, no sugar-added, and whole grain items.

HEALTH KITS

The Joe Gribble Sunday School Class is putting together Health Kits for Lutheran World Relief. Collection boxes are located in the Gribble classroom. Items needed are:

- Dark colored, lightweight cotton bath sized towels (20' x 40" to 52" x 27")
- Bath sized bars of soap
- Sturdy combs
- Metal nail clipper with packaging removed.
