WEDNESDAY EVENING LENTEN SERVICES

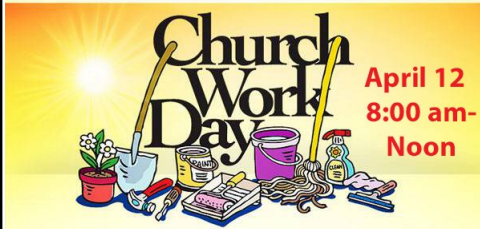
