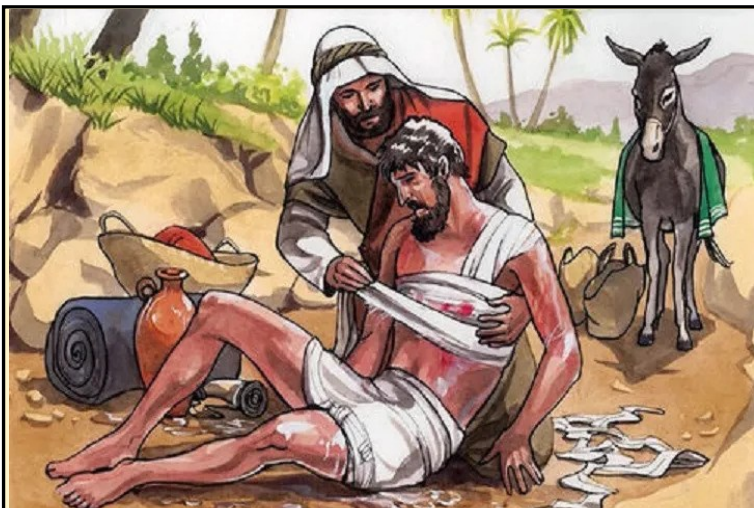

NEW SOCIAL MINISTRY PROGRAM



The Social Ministry Committee met with Second Harvest and CCM staff to start a new project for Kimball. The program is called CSFP (Commodity Supplemental Food Program) and is a government sponsored monthly food distribution for Seniors. We will start with deliveries up to 29 individuals and keep up with the calls and paperwork required. Our plan is to host the deliveries on the fourth Monday of each month, 8:30-10:00 am, starting in July. CCM will assist with enrolling clients and bringing the packaged food to Kimball. Right now, we will use the committee for distribution, but we will be needing some more volunteers in the future.
