We celebrate the mystery of the Holy Trinity in word and sacrament, as we profess the creed, and as we are sent into the world to bear witness to our faith.

We want the congregation to be aware of updates/improvements regarding our Sound System, which will be completed over the next weeks. The work will provide four new microphones, the transition of our choir microphones to wireless, improvements in our radio frequency distribution which will improve our sound quality both in the Sanctuary and on-line, and installation/tuning/training of the new system. Bids were received and carefully considered by both our Executive Committee and Congregation Council, with the chosen bid at \$15,800.
