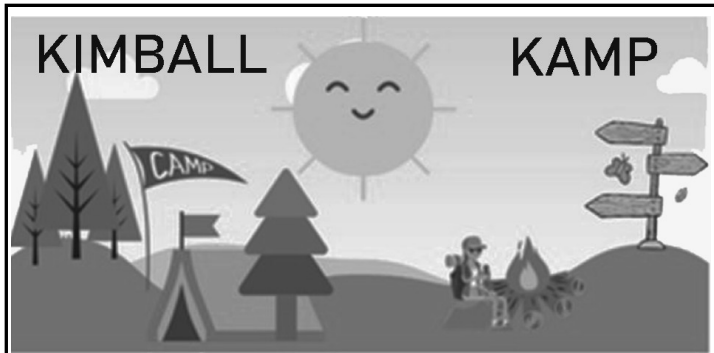


CELEBRATE AMERICA CONCERT
