[] Discipline - Hunter/Jumper

A [] Beginner - Can comfortably walk/trot a horse on their own.

B [] Novice - Can comfortably walk/trot/canter a horse on their own.

C [] Intermediate - Can w/t/c, and has started jumping

D [] Advanced - Can w/t/c, jumping courses of up to 2'6"

E [] Amateur - Jumping courses up to 3'0, has been off property to some shows

F [] Seasoned - Jumping courses 1.0m +, comfortable riding green, young and hot horses

G [] Pro - Competing regularly, training and developing horses, jumping 1.20m+

[] Discipline - Dressage

- A [] Beginner - Can comfortably walk/trot a horse on their own.
- B [] Novice - Can comfortably walk/trot/canter a horse on their own.
- C [] Introductory - Can w/t/c a horse, and started riding dressage patterns
- D [] Training - riding dressage tests with basic movements & patterns
- E [] First Level - riding with consistent contact, sitting the trot, able to collect and lengthen all 3 gaits
- F [] Second Level - shoulder-in, travers, turn on haunches
- G [] Third Level - flying changes, renvers, half-pass
- H [] Fourth Level - pirouette, counter canter
- I [] Pro - Riding at Prix St. George or Grand Prix Level

[] Discipline - Eventing

- A [] Entry -comfortable riding smaller cross country jumps, stadium jumps to 0.75, can ride a basic dressage test w/t/c
- B [] Pre-Training - comfortable riding cross country jumps as a course, stadium courses to 0.9m, riding dressage tests with basic movements & collection
- C [] Training - riding cross country jumps such as banks, ditches, combinations, stadium courses 1.0m, dressage tests with more intricate patterns & movements
- D [] Prelim - competing at events, comfortable with all types of cross jumps, stadium courses 1.0m+, up to 2nd level dressage movements.
- E [] Intermediate and Above - competing regularly, capable of riding young, green and hot horses

[] Discipline - Hacking/Pleasure (Western or English)

- A [] Pleasure Rider - w/t, enjoy casually riding out on the trail or in the arena.
- B [] Out For Fun - w/t/c, enjoy shipping out to new areas or participating in hunter paces, etc.

[] Discipline - Western (reining, pleasure, etc.)

A [] Basic - w/t/c in an arena or out on the trail

B [] Reiner - learning reining or looking to compete in reining

C [] Pleasure - learning western pleasure or looking to compete in western pleasure

D [] Wrangler - using the horse for ranch/farm work regularly

Agreement of Services

I _____ hereby agree to hire Alicia Chaulk/The Horse Shopper. I agree to pay all fees outlined in the services and rates document provided to me, for which I will incur over the period of hiring The Horse Shopper. If I do not pay the total sum of the invoice sent to me by The Horse Shopper within 15 days of receipt, I acknowledge that 5% of the total bill will be added on every 30 days from receipt.

I acknowledge that if I do not purchase a horse through The Horse Shopper, that I will forfeit my deposit.

If I choose to privately purchase a horse that The Horse Shopper has shown to me directly from the seller, I acknowledge that The Horse Shopper is still entitled to bill me a Finder's Fee, which I agree to pay.

I will not hold Alicia Chaulk, and/or The Horse Shopper liable (not limited to but including, injury, harm, damage and death caused during and after the horse shopping process & purchase) I acknowledge that The Horse Shopper/Alicia Chaulk simply acts as a mediator between buyer and seller, and cannot guarantee a horse's soundness, represented state, riding ability, age, breed, etc. as this information is the responsibility of the seller.

If I choose to return a horse to the seller, the transaction will purely be between buyer and seller, and the Finder's fee and other service charges from The Horse Shopper will not be refunded. The Horse Shopper is willing to work with their clients on finding a different horse if this instance occurs.

I agree to leave my credit card information on file with Alicia Chaulk/The Horse Shopper, and acknowledge that if my total bill is not paid 60 days from receipt, The

Horse Shopper will charge the balance to my credit card + a 2.5% processing fee. A blank signed cheque may be used in place of a credit card.
