
# COUNTY FAIR NOMINATION & ENTRY



#### **BARN HOURS**

Barns are open everyday from 6 am to 9 pm. Make arrangements to make sure your animals have been taken care of, including feeding, watering and clean stalls within those hours. If an emergency arises and you are unable to finish care for your animal by those hours, please contact a Fair Board Member.

#### SHAVINGS

Shavings are available to purchase through the Fair Office. You are able pay with cash, check or charge them against your fair check. If you choose to charge them, you must pay them off by the end of fair. You are also welcome to bring your own shavings for your animal(s).

# ARRIVAL TIME

Each species has their own check-in and arrival time. Check the Fair Schedule for your arrival time. If you need to arrive before your arrival time, you need to make arrangements before you arrive. Late arrivals are not accepted and you will not be allowed to unload your animal.

#### CHECK-OUT

When you are ready to leave with your non-sale animals, you need to check out with your specie(s) superintendent. If your superintendent is not available, please find a Fair Board member. Make sure you remove all zip-ties, wires or anything else you added to your stall. Stripping out of your stall is very much appreciated.

## **RULES & REGS**
