## **BORN & RAISED**

Entries in these classes will be judged immediately following feeder classes for Beef, Swine, Sheep and Market Goats.

- 1. The purpose of the Born and Raised division is to promote and recognize exhibitors who are involved in animal production.
- 2. All General, Livestock and Department rules apply.
- 3. These classes are open to all Junior exhibitors who show a market goat, lamb, swine, or beef that was born to a dam that was owned by the Exhibitor or by a member of the immediate family (Mother, Father, Brother or Sister) at the time of birth. The animal must be born and raised in one of our six exhibiting counties (Saguache, Rio Grande, Alamosa, Costilla, Conejos and Mineral). Exhibitors may be asked to prove ownership. Failure to prove ownership will disqualify animals from the contest and exhibitors will relinquish awards.
- 4. In order to qualify for the Born and Raised class the animal must be entered and shown in their regular market class, make market weight and/or be market ready as described in each species market rules.
- 5. Born & Raised competitors should enter their animal(s) in the Born & Raised class, in addition to the general market class.
- 6. Feeder class and overweight animals are not eligible for Born & Raised.

## **AWARDS**

Grand and Reserve Champion in each species.
