FULL TRANSPARENCY

- 1. Artists must abide by local health regulations; very basic and consistent to the health regulations in many other states.
- 2. Board of Health fees must be prepaid prior to working
- 3. Artists/Studios need to pay temporary licensing fees
- Artists need to bring blood borne pathogens & cross contamination prevention certificates for Board of Health inspections prior to be allowed to work
- 5. Setup must be complete at least (1) hour before doors have opened!!!
- 6. Break down cannot start until (1) hour after doors have closed to the event!!! It is not polite to the attendees and fellow artists at the festival.
- 7. Artists are responsible for following all Health Regulations required by the state.
- 8. Artists must create a "Check in Packet." Have all clients thoroughly read, fill out and sign all release/ consent forms. Care and aftercare instructions MUST be INCLUDED in packets.
- 9. Your shop or yourself must have a QR Code to be considered!
- 10. Your shop or yourself must have a website, Instagram, Facebook and/or webpage to be considered!
- 11. Gloves must be worn when tattooing or piercing a client at all times
- 12. Artist must comply with all needle agreements; care instructions and client release forms
- 13. Artists must inform all clients in regards to how to heal their new tattoos
- 14. Artists must bandage all new tattoos with lap cloths or dry lock materials only. No clear saran wraps!
- 15. Sharps containers must be used. Each booth will have a complimentary sharps container provided!
- 16. All needles & razors must be properly disposed of into the sharps containers provided at your booth
- 17. Pre-packaged, sterile instruments must be used during all tattooing and piercing procedures

- 18. Be sure to bring enough disposable tubes and instruments to get you through the busy weekend. Ink the Bay will have an exclusive supplier present.
- 19. Anyone caught scrubbing tubes will be in violation of health codes and will be asked to leave the event and its premises IMMEDIATELY
- 20. Suppliers will be present at the event
- 21. Artist must comply with all needle agreements; care instructions and client release forms.
- 22. Artists must inform all clients in regards to how to heal their new tattoos.
- 23. Artists must bandage all new tattoos with lap cloths or dry lock materials only. No clear saran wraps!
- 24. Any individual may enter any contest that matches.
- 25. All competing tattoos for all categories must be FULLY HEALED (with the exception of tattoo of the day).
