

The US Digital Divide in the early 2020s


- The digital divide actually grew!






BEAD is Your Call to Action

\$42.5B Broadband Equity, Access, & Deployment (BEAD) Program

- Eligibility rules: unserved (25/3 Mbps) & underserved (100/20 Mbps)
- Unlicensed fixed wireless and satellite projects will be overbuilt
- Expect that funding will flow in the second half of 2024



Long-term vision Fiber is the priority technology










Simplify. Excite. Grow.



Be aware of the sleeping giants – Tier 1s and 2s








It's about getting your voice heard (2 of 3)
