

A Dad's Cry to See His Son Again in Heaven



If we look at the Garden of Eden and ask ourselves, "Why were we kicked out?" This question is vital and life altering.

Once humanity ate from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, we possessed knowledge we were never meant to have, which gave us the ability to determine good and evil for ourselves. Because of this, we had to be removed from the Garden before we could eat from the Tree of Life. There was no way humanity would be allowed to eat from the Tree of Life while possessing the knowledge of good and evil. If that happened, mankind would become god-like for eternity.

Think about that for a moment.

We were removed from Eden because we ate from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Yet today we continue using that same knowledge every hour of every day. We constantly decide what is good, what is bad, what is right, and what is wrong according to our own understanding.

Do you honestly believe we will simply walk into Heaven while still clinging to the very thing that removed us from Eden?

As seen with Adam and Eve, that did not work out very well.

Spiritual knowledge is the only way into Heaven. Intellectual knowledge will be cast into the fire during judgment. The situations, choices, and actions directed by Spiritual knowledge will remain in your favor. When you stand before Yahweh and Jesus, what knowledge do you want to present? The knowledge that separated humanity from Yahweh, or the knowledge that leads you back to Him?

Adam opened the age of intellectual knowledge; Jesus reopened the age of Spiritual knowledge.

Jesus began cleansing humanity's bloodline by becoming the first human to perfectly align flesh, blood, and Spirit with the Father's desires. Man's entire accumulated intellectual failures were no longer being added to; they were now ready to be transformed.

Next listen to a father as he explains to his child "How Sin Travels through our Blood" by scripture's eyes.

Leviticus 17:11

"For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement."

Our flesh loves sin, and sin hides inside our blood, that pumps to our hearts

Leviticus 17:14

"For as for the life of all flesh, its blood is identified with its life."

When we sin, it is like wearing wet and muddy clothes & nobody wants to wear muddy clothes. Our sins must be washed away so we can have clean clothes

Ezekiel 36:26-27

"Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new Spirit within you... and cause you to walk in My statutes."

The Holy Spirit is the gift of clean clothes given to us by Yahweh. He promises to always give us clean clothes. We should promise not to dirty them with sin.

Exodus 24:8

"So Moses took the blood and sprinkled it on the people, and said, 'Behold the blood of the covenant, which the Lord has made with you in accordance with all these words.'"

When we promise to listen to Yahweh, it is recorded into our blood. We must always follow the Holy Spirit to honor our promise until we leave earth

Psalms 51:5

"Behold, I was brought forth in guilt, and in sin my mother conceived me."

Yahweh spiritually protects you as a child from our family's sin that is hiding within your bloodline

Genesis 6:5

"The Lord saw that the wickedness of mankind was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of their hearts was only evil continually."

If you ignore the Holy Spirit, all our family's sin will slowly attack you from the inside, until it kills you

Genesis 4:10

"And He said, 'What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood is crying out to Me from the ground.'"

Know that our blood holds memories haunting us like a never-ending story

John 6:53-56

"Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves"..

When we ignore the Holy Spirit, we begin to follow our blood's sinful, worldly, and intellectual knowledge, which causes sin.

Following Jesus feeds the Holy Spirit and keeps us spiritually strong to fight against sin

Matthew 26:28

"For this is My blood of the covenant, which is being poured out for many for forgiveness of sins."

Jesus' blood is the Holy Spirit that dwells within us. He flows through our bodies, guiding our hearts to walk as Jesus did. Only the Spirit should know whether something is good or bad.

John 5:19

"Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, unless it is something He sees the Father doing."

The Holy Spirit is priceless and is worth more than anything your flesh could ever desire. It is to follow Jesus by using only spiritual knowledge. The Holy Spirit will take you to Heaven so that we may live together again forever. You cannot buy your way into Heaven.

Son, this is the only thing of value I have left to give. I have no money, no retirement, and no life insurance. I will leave you nothing behind that others consider valuable in this world.

John 16:13

"But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth."

We must die to the knowledge of good and evil, the intellectual knowledge we use all the time. We are spiritually reborn when we are baptized into spiritual knowledge

John 1:12-13

"...He gave the right to become children of God... who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God."

Spiritual knowledge becomes our new life. Even adults should live like kids. Only the Holy Spirit is to know what is good and what` is bad

Exodus 34:7

"...visiting the iniquity of fathers on the children and on the grandchildren to the third and fourth generations."

Son, you cannot run from sin; it's inside your bloodline. Our blood can keep us alive, or it can kill us through sin by attacking our minds and hearts

Revelation 1:5

"To Him who loves us and released us from our sins by His blood."

All we need to do is listen to the Holy Spirit and follow Jesus into Heaven

Revelation 5:9

"For You were slaughtered, and You purchased people for God with Your blood..."

Jesus paid the price so that all His true believers and followers may have the chance to live for eternity. You must always spiritually fight for this. I'm sorry I made it harder on you by the sin I allowed you to witness while I was alive. This is why you have Yahweh, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit to do what I nor any man on earth could do: be a true father for a child to follow

Picture this; You're at a bus stop waiting for Jesus' bus ride to Heaven.

First, you must realize the Holy Spirit is driving this bus. We are only passengers on the ride of faith. This bus stops for followers and disciples of Jesus whose works of faith and Spiritual gifts are needed to fill the gas tank. Without Spiritual fuel the bus remains parked going nowhere on earth.

Our responsibility is not to question every turn but to trust the One driving. Intellectual knowledge constantly asks, "Where are we going and why?"

Spiritual knowledge says, "I trust the Holy Spirit as the driver." He has the destination entered into the GPS for the Kingdom of Heaven already.

Why would I use intellect to travel to a destination that is unknown, or to follow another human there? Remember, not one person walking on this earth has that exact address.

Now the question becomes, how do we replace intellectual knowledge with Spiritual knowledge, so we can ride this bus and pass through the narrow gate!

That is easy. First ask yourself. What is the first thing you do when you wake up every morning? Is it to say "Thank you, Jesus, for one more day on earth?" Or maybe you think of your to do's for the day?

This includes work, bills, hobbies, exercise, or family responsibilities. Maybe it's in addition to saving for your retirement or planning a cool vacation, attending church, and going to bible study. We are still chasing a form of intellect.

Think about all the hours that are wasted each week on things that add up to nothing on a Spiritual level.

If you were to take those same hours, change your mindset, and show your family a true Spiritual walk with Jesus, then you would most likely succeed in leading your family, yourself, and others toward Heaven.

Does your lifestyle, responsibilities, worldly commitments, and achievements matter more than the people you love? Stop thinking! You can say all the words in the world and sound as biblically intellectual as you wish.

However, your actions tell the true story. They reveal what is written from your heart which exposes the reality of your faith and love. This is the truth, and it cannot be hidden. Most people live for these things every day. In one way or another, that is intellectual knowledge directing your eternal life.

Personally, I'm trying to adapt to Spiritual knowledge, letting the intellectual knowledge die as it should. This is very difficult and can only be done by relying on Jesus and the Holy Spirit to save us! Let's dive a little deeper into this. Spiritual knowledge is different. It wakes you up and says:

"Jesus, I've been waiting, and I'm ready to move on from earth and return to You!"

Our first thought in the morning should be to pray for Spiritual guidance through the Holy Spirit so that we may lead our kids, family, everyone we love, know, and may meet today, alongside ourselves, into Heaven, so that we may be rewarded with eternal life with Jesus and all others we love." Shouldn't that be our most important concern every morning when we awaken: to return to Heaven and live an eternity with the people we hold dear?

Yet, our focus is often to remain on Earth, living exactly as we should not, with hopes we can remain here as long as possible with our loved ones. Again, this is twisted insanity. If we are holding on to the life of this world, chasing material and fleshly desires, wanting to remain here rather than be in Heaven, that is a prime example that we may not genuinely believe in Jesus as our Savior.

If you lived thinking, "Today is the day I meet my Creator," what would your day look like? Imagine if you knew you had a meeting with Jesus later in the evening after your works of faith were complete. After such a day, you now sit down at one of the most important meetings of your life. It is called your second judgment, where the works of faith you completed on Earth, will be discussed. Our purpose driven works of faith should always be done, as Jesus performed them, mainly for the needy, not the healthy. You should never ask yourself, what would Jesus do? You should always look into his commands and sermon and say, "What has Jesus done?"

A great example of this would be the Great Commission, found in the book of Matthew. He commands us to go, and tell others who do not know of him, that He is their Savior.

Instead, we often sit in church talking to others who are already aware that Jesus is their Savior. That is the exact opposite of what we should be doing according to Jesus' command. This should raise a major concern for you to meditate on, while in prayer.

However, our true focus daily is usually on the healthy, primarily our family's lifestyle, which is the opposite of what we should be doing according to Jesus' commands and His one and only documented sermon. Remember, the healthy do not need a doctor. Scripture supports, When Jesus was told that His family was waiting outside, He corrected them and said that He was already with His family right then and there. With this readjustment, I bet your day may look like this;

You might cook a better breakfast for your family. You may prepare extra food or grab items around the house that you no longer use for someone in need.

Before leaving the house, you would hug your wife, husband, children, or loved ones a little tighter than usual and give them a kiss that would last in your memory until you saw them again, hopefully in eternity.

Are you beginning to understand Spiritual knowledge?

When you go to work, you will probably work a little harder. Not because you desire more money, you know Yahweh will provide daily needs. It should be to witness and testify by shining your light so co-workers may see Jesus is inside of you one last time! You would be kinder to strangers. You would pay more attention to those in need. You might say to yourself, "I am going to meet Jesus today, and I know He would want me to tell others about Him. Maybe I can help someone else meet Him too." Then when you see Him, you can talk about how cool those experiences were together. If someone cuts you off in traffic, insults you, or creates a miserable situation around you, you probably won't lose your temper. You are not going to explode in anger. You will likely shake your head, let it go, and move on. Why? Because what lies ahead is far more important than arguing with fools.

Think back to when you were five years old. There was probably someone very special in your life whom you loved dearly. Whenever they came home after being gone, you ran to them with everything you had. You hugged them. You kissed them. You were excited simply because they were there. You did not need a book. You did not need Scripture. You did not need advice. You did not need to determine good from evil. You simply followed love within your heart. You were naturally programmed to think Spiritually. We are born with Spiritual knowledge. It is the world that changes us.

As we grow, we slowly leave Spiritual knowledge behind and adopt the intellectual knowledge taught to us every day. We are taught to keep eating from the fruit of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Society tells us it is normal. The world tells us it is wisdom.

Even most pastors, often stand on stage teaching biblical knowledge, which is still a form of intellectual knowledge.

But Spiritual knowledge is different. It does not simply know about Yahweh, it follows Him. This is what baptism is meant to accomplish in our lives. We are to walk away from intellectual knowledge, allowing our old selves to die, and come out of the water reborn into a new life of Spiritual knowledge led by the Holy Spirit. If you jump out of that water with excitement but still cling to intellectual knowledge, then you have cleansed nothing more than the exterior of your skin.

The old self remains unchanged. True baptism is not merely about entering and leaving the water. It is about dying to the old way of life and being reborn into a new one

From Adam to Mary, Jesus' DNA became one gigantic testimony of humanity's inability to follow Yahweh's desires. Then came the moment when all the lessons, failures, and recorded history of mankind would be tested and fulfilled through one man. Where everyone before Him failed, Jesus succeeded.

Where mankind was disobedient, Jesus was obedient. Where mankind sought its own will, Jesus sought Yahweh's will. Where mankind fell into temptation, Jesus overcame temptation. The bloodline that once carried the record of humanity's failures ultimately produced the One who fulfilled what humanity could not. In this way, the story is transformed. The failures did not become the final testimony.

What generations could not accomplish through their own knowledge, strength, or wisdom was finally accomplished through Jesus. The lesson is simple: Humanity failed. Jesus did not. Through Him, the failures of the past become a testimony of Yahweh's Spiritual plan rather than a testimony of mankind's intellectual success. Once you realize this, it sets the stage for the correction that should transform our hearts so we can truly follow Jesus.

When mankind was exiled from Eden and sent into the wilderness, the path back to Yahweh required purification. Baptism is that Spiritual purification. It symbolizes the death of the old intellectual self and the beginning of a new Spiritual life. Even Jesus was baptized. By doing so, He fulfilled all righteousness for what the Israelites and others throughout the Old Testament failed to do: allow their need to provide for themselves through intellect to die.

The wilderness and the exiled moments throughout Scripture are meant to teach us to always look toward Yahweh if we want to live, especially in these times. They show us that, within the wilderness, man cannot provide for himself when there is nothing available, no matter how much intellect they may possess in life.

Once Jesus was baptized, He went into the wilderness to face His test. He had to succeed where all others had failed. Jesus defeated the evil one by consuming Spiritual food, not the intellectual temptations the evil one was providing.

When we enter the water, we are giving up our old lives so that we may be reborn. This includes the death of intellectual thinking, so that we may walk according to Spiritual understanding. Just as exile followed disobedience, purification comes before restoration.

However, many of us want to hold on to our old selves and the way we have been taught to think since birth. We want a new life without letting go of the old one. Simply coming out of the water and feeling different is not rebirth.

Rebirth is a new mindset. Rebirth is choosing to feed the Spirit instead of the flesh. The Spirit within us must be continually fed. Just as our bodies need food each day, our Spirits need Spiritual nourishment each day. If we continue feeding the Spirit with the same thinking that led mankind into exile, we should not be surprised when we continue struggling and having difficulties within our life. But if we feed the Spirit what it truly desires, we begin to walk the path that Jesus demonstrated for us.

It is about no longer living for our own desires, our own plans, our own intellect, and our own will. It is about living as though our lives already belong to Yahweh. If the old self is truly dead, then there is nothing left to protect, nothing left to preserve, and nothing left to cling to. Only Yahweh's will remains.

The water itself does not change us. The change comes from the new heart, the new mind, and the gift of the Holy Spirit that chooses to follow Yahweh's desires within you. Baptism is the outward sign of that inward transformation and the Spiritual purification that prepares us for the Kingdom of Heaven.

When we examine the lives of the Martyrs and the Apostles, we see a picture of what it means to die to the old self. Many of them did not appear to be seeking death. Rather, they appeared to have completely surrendered to Yahweh's desires. Their lives no longer belonged to themselves.

Perhaps this is why they could face suffering, persecution, and even death with such confidence. They had already given up ownership of their lives. The old self was already dead. Their hopes, plans, desires, and future had already been placed into Yahweh's hands.

From their perspective, they were not losing their lives. They believed they were entering into life. Perhaps this lesson was easier to understand during their time because of the environmental and lifestyle conditions in which they lived.

In contrast, we are often happy and content within the artificial garden of Eden Satan has created for our lifestyles that keeps us comfortable and attached to this world. Maybe this is where some of the confusion surrounding baptism exists today. We often view baptism as just a moment, a special event, or an incredible feeling afterwards. But perhaps the early believers understood that being reborn meant surrendering ownership of their lives so they could truly be reborn for Heaven.

Jesus' commands and His Sermon on the Mount intellectually explain the Spiritual transformation we must undergo to enter Heaven. Because we possess the knowledge of good and evil, the path back to Spiritual understanding requires us to unlearn much of what we have been taught by adults since birth. We must learn to let go of the intellect that came from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil and return to trusting Yahweh. Jesus left His commands and His sermon behind so that we may continually correct ourselves and find the answers needed to overcome our worldly way of thinking. It is the mirror that allows us to see a reflection of ourselves. It has nothing to do with the involvement of others. Although the outcome may benefit others, the wisdom left behind is for a complete transformation so that we may think Spiritually. Jesus' teachings redirect our minds toward Yahweh's desires.

They are not merely a list of rules. The teachings of Jesus are not the destination. They are guideposts that point us toward Spiritual transformation. When followed correctly, they awaken faith within us and allow intellect to become Spiritual understandings that grow inside us.

Like a garden growing toward Yahweh's light of life. As that Spiritual understanding grows, we will one day be ready to be transplanted from the wilderness back into Eden. This is how we prepare ourselves to pass the second judgment and enter into the Kingdom of Heaven.

Now imagine standing before Yahweh at the final judgment and every part of your life is separated into two bodies!

One body is built from your own works, your own understanding, your own intellect, and the knowledge of good and evil. Every time you chose your will over Yahweh's will, another piece was added to that body. The other body is built through obedience to Jesus. Every act of faith, every act of love, every act of mercy, every sacrifice, and every moment spent following Yahweh, adds another piece to that body. As your life is examined, both bodies begin to take shape.

The body built from self is destined for destruction. It is the old you, the flesh, the intellect, and the life that remains attached to the world. The body built through following Jesus is the one fit for the Kingdom. Now ask yourself: Which one of these bodies, representing your life, today, is more complete and truly reflects who you became after baptism?

The danger is standing before Yahweh and realizing that the body formed through following Jesus was never fully developed. If most of your life was spent building the body of self, then that is the body that remains and will be cast into the fire, never to be seen in Heaven again. But if your life was spent becoming more like Jesus, then that is the body that will be welcomed into the Kingdom of Heaven to remain with Yahweh for eternity.

Every day we are building one body or the other. Every thought, every choice, and every action add another body part. The question is simple: When you stand before Yahweh, which body will be complete?

Once you realize that Spiritual knowledge is tasting the great Word of Yahweh, you will not want to feed your Spirit anything else. This is why Jesus is our Savior. He is here to save us from ourselves, like a Shepherd guiding His flock through a land that wishes to consume them. But He leads them safely toward the Kingdom of Heaven.
