Deepalaya is a grassroots organization working to empower women and children in and around district of Purnea, Bihar. Since its inception in 1999, Deepalaya has been relentlessly reaching out to the most marginalized groups of women at various locations including women from the red light areas and slums. Deepalaya, mounted with a cause to serve mainly the specially abled individuals of the society, is one of the first rehab facilities to have been established in the eastern area of Purnia, Bihar. We acquired our shape of society under the SR ACT IXX 1860 in the year 1999 .

Deepalaya designed and operated tasks with a stern believe in uplifting the civil repute of the Persons with disability, the ordinary public mainly the ladies and children. The COVID-19 pandemic has presented an unparalleled scenario throughout the world. As the organization and its target agencies the PwD's, adolescent and women, their stakeholders, had been severely impacted, we proceed to tirelessly work toward the recognition of our vision to acquire a society that respects the rights of adolescent children and women.

RSETI i.e; Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) are established with of identifying, training, motivating & facilitating unemployed youth to take up self-employment. This is considered as an effective model for creation of sustainable livelihoods through Self Employment. SBI is managing 152 RSETIs in 26 States and 3 UTs out of 589 functional RSETIs in the country. RSETIs transform unemployed rural youth in the districts into

confident self-employed entrepreneurs through need-based training program followed by systematic handholding support and bank linkage. COMMUNITY OUTREACH CAMPAIGN



To spread a message on the importance of sanitization and vaccination amongst the crowd a Community Outreach Campaign was carried out .

With the help 49 Community outreach Workers (COW's) we escalated our campaign amongst 7000 households spread over 3 blocks in close proximity. We restricted the perimeter to make it easy for our COW's to operate without much hassle. The campaign was carried out in phases; **May 2020 - October 2020 & May 2021 - July 2021**. Surveys were done to

counter the migrations in and out of Purnia district. Proper trainings for self care and sanitization were taught to each file worker for better safety cautions. It was a commendable effort and an act of bravery that our filed workers displayed taking up this tasks in such difficult times. Each COW was given a smartphone with the help of which the workers virtually, with the help of videos, demonstrated the correct way to use sanitizers according to WHO guidelines. They also brought to light various misconception about COVID-19 vaccines.



EARTH DAY



Earth Day is an annual event on **April 22** to demonstrate support for environmental protection. Forest ecosystems are a critical component of the world's biodiversity as many forests are more biodiverse than other ecosystems. Forests cover 31 percent of the global land area. Deforestation and forest degradation continue to take place at alarming rates, which contributes significantly to the ongoing loss of biodiversity. On this occasion we **planted around 100 trees** in open areas. This trees included varieties of Ashok , Sisam, Mahogany, Sagwan, Jackfruit, lemon, Java Plum.

RATION DISTRIBUTION



On 31st August 2020, Deepalaya with support of its partner Nomi Network Inc. organized a Relief Distribution program among the marginalized and affected people of the community.

The objectives of this program included:

- To spread awareness on following the Covid-19 mandatory guidelines of the government.
- To improve the safety health practices of wearing masks, using hand sanitizers and maintaining 2ft minimal distance in crowded areas.
- Distributing rations among the needy to help them cope with the situations.



- To spread knowledge about humanitarian services for the needy in hard times.

We knew about the ongoing situation then, it had started to become worst as the days passed. Government had organized complete lockdowns throughout the country. COVID-19 prevention guidelines were imposed stating right measures to keep one safe from getting infected. The most vulnerable section of our society, the labor class was the most affected section during this period. Mostly including the daily wage workers lost their jobs. Migrant labors returned to their homes, jobless.

FLOOD is another major disaster that affects regions of Bihar, creating great havoc and loss of lives, homes and life-stock. This year flood was an added calamity with the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. This had left people in great distress as there was lack of support facilities due to the worldwide pandemic.

It was a great achievement for all of us. We helped nearly 62 households by distributing dry rations: Wheat flour/Ashirwad aata(5kgs), Rice(10kgs), Dal(3kgs), Sugar/Chini(3Kgs), Tea leaves/Chai patti(2.5kgs), Soyabean chunks(250gms), Fortune Mustard oil(1kgs), 50 masks, 20 pcs 50 ml Hand sanitizers.

Our Community Outreach Workers put forward a praiseworthy outcome of their awareness program. They were praised by the family members from among the 69 households we helped. It was indeed a very noble step towards helping the marginalized sections of the community. Reaching this section of society and helping their way out with ration and basic safety gears gave us an immense feeling of joyfulness and motivated us to carry on our journey towards our goal of making our society a better place for the unprivileged.
