
Q1 When the ban or guidance against churches meeting are lifted, which best describes your attitude toward returning to a worship service at St. Stephen's? Select one:




Q2 In addition to the government lifting its ban or guidance against public gatherings, are there other signals you would want to see before you return to attend a worship service at church? Select all that apply





Q5 If you participate in group events, such as Bible Study or Adult Christian Education, would you be willing to attend meetings where they typically meet?



Q6 Which of the following describes the attendance level at which you would be comfortable attending a worship service? I would be comfortable attending if the sanctuary is...



Q7 When the government lifts the ban or guidance against public gatherings, which of the following would you prefer for our church?




Q8 Would you be willing to attend a worship service at a different time than you typically attend to allow people to be more spread out in the sanctuary?


