



BURLESON FFA ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



The Burleson FFA Alumni Scholarship was established in 2017 to recognize and reward students who have been active participants in the BISD FFA programs. A total of \$3,000 in 4 scholarships, 2 for Burleson High School and 2 for Centennial High School will be awarded to deserving students.

Two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 for 1 student at BHS and 1 at CHS who meet all general criteria, plus;

- Participated in at least 2 of the 3 disciplines (CDE, LDE, or SAE) for at least the most recent 6 semesters (Sophomore, Junior, and Senior years)

Two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$500 for 1 student at BHS and 1 at CHS who meet all general criteria, plus;

- Participated in a least 2 of the 3 disciplines (CDE, LDE, or SAE) for at least the most recent 4 semesters (Junior and Senior years)

Eligible Applicants Must:

- Be graduating from Burleson High School or Centennial High School
- Be a member in good standing of the FFA program
- Be accepted to attend College, University, or Trade School for the Fall 2021 semester

All Applicants Must Submit the following Required Documentation:

1. A completed Burleson FFA Alumni scholarship application (attached below)
2. One letter of recommendation (from a Teacher, Counselor, or Administrator)
3. A 400-500 word essay on the topic of "The FFA Motto" Essays must be typed and double-spaced
4. A copy of your High School Transcript

Burleson FFA Alumni Scholarship Selection Criteria

As a not-for-profit organization, Burleson FFA Alumni is committed to awarding scholarships on the basis of dedication to FFA and its motto. Applicants will be considered based on their completed application, level of participation, letter of recommendation, and quality of essay.

Selection is made without regard to applicant(s) race, color, national origin, religious belief, gender, marital status, age, or physical handicap.

Complete packets will be reviewed by a minimum of three (3) individuals who are familiar with FFA, but independent of the local program.

All applicants will receive a confirmation of receipt within seven (7) business days.

Awards will be presented during the Senior Awards Ceremony held each spring and/or at the Chapter FFA Banquet.

Payments will be made directly to the University, College, or Trade School on behalf of the recipient. Payment information must be provided in writing to the Burleson FFA Alumni within 60 days of the first day of class. In the event that a recipient does not provide the required information, the award will be forfeited and the funds will be used for future scholarship awards.
