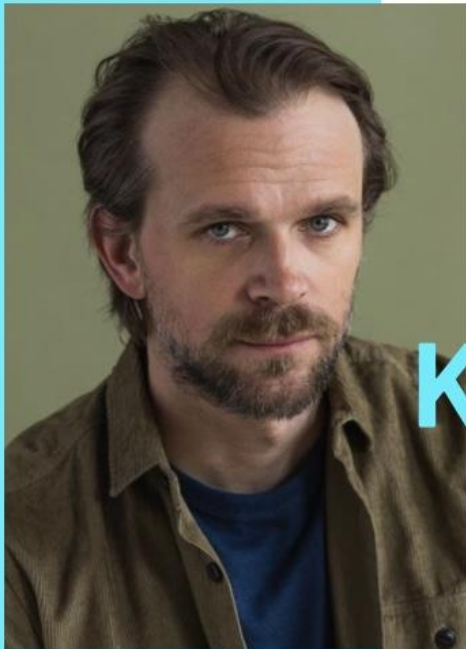


# BRANDON JAMES SIM
