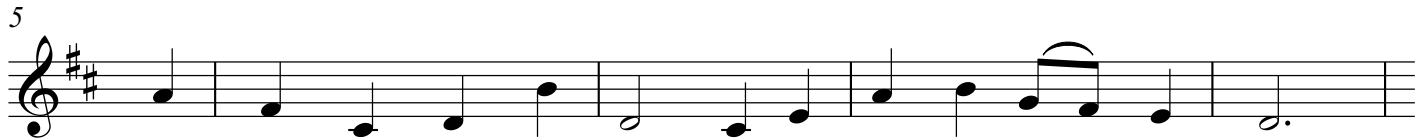
### Introit
