## 1<sup>st</sup> reading: Jeremiah 1.4-10

A reading from the book of the prophet Jeremiah.

<sup>4</sup> The word of the LORD came to me saying,  
<sup>5</sup> 'Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations.'

<sup>6</sup> Then I said, 'Ah, Lord GOD! Truly I do not know how to speak, for I am only a boy.'

<sup>7</sup> But the LORD said to me, 'Do not say, "I am only a boy"; for you shall go to all to whom I send you, and you shall speak whatever I command you,

<sup>8</sup> Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, says the LORD.'

<sup>9</sup> Then the LORD put out his hand and touched my mouth; and the LORD said to me, 'Now I have put my words in your mouth.'

<sup>10</sup> See, today I appoint you over nations and over kingdoms, to pluck up and to pull down, to destroy and to overthrow, to build and to plant.'

This is the word of the Lord.

## 2nd reading: Galatians 1.11-16a

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Galatians.

<sup>11</sup> I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel that was proclaimed by me is not of human origin;  
<sup>12</sup> for I did not receive it from a human source, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

<sup>13</sup> You have heard, no doubt, of my earlier life in Judaism. I was violently persecuting the church of God and was trying to destroy it.

<sup>14</sup> I advanced in Judaism beyond many among my people of the same age, for I was far more zealous for the traditions of my ancestors.

<sup>15</sup> But when God, who had set me apart before I was born and called me through his grace, was pleased

<sup>16</sup> to reveal his Son to me, so that I might proclaim him among the Gentiles, I did not confer with any human being.

This is the word of the Lord.
