- A. The Countries/Nations Involved in the War Against Great Britain (1764-1783)
  - 1. Great Britain
  - 2. The Colonies of Great Britain in North America (excluding Canada)
  - 3. France
  - 4. Spain
  - 5. Native American Nations
  - 6. Selected German States (who sent mercenaries to fight for the UK)
- B. With the end of the Seven Years War (1756-63), Great Britain was now the most powerful colonial power in North America, with France having ceded most of its North American colonies to the UK
- C. The Spanish empire in the Western Hemisphere was far larger than that of the UK, France or any other European power. After the end of the Seven Years War, the UK was concerned that both France and Spain would rearm and seek to limit British power in the Western Hemisphere.
- D. By the time of the increasing rupture between settlers in the colonies and the British government (1770-1775), a truly global economy was operating that encompassed the international slave trade, the production of raw materials and their shipment across the seas from North America and the Caribbean to Europe and the importing of both finished goods and raw materials by British colonists in North America from Europe, Asia, Central and South America and the Caribbean.
- E. These global links between the British colonies of North America and the rest of the world also included cultural exchanges: music, dance, visual arts, literature

and crafts. Today's musical selections present a cross-section of what you might have heard during the period of the American Revolution.
