Flu vaccine and COVID 19 vaccine

Question: When is the ideal time to get the flu shot?

Now is a great time to get your flu shot. The CDC recommends annual flu shots for everyone over 6 months of age before flu begins circulating in communities and by the end of October to help reduce spread of flu. It takes about two weeks after the vaccine for antibodies to develop in the body and provide protection

against the flu.

Question: If a COVID-19 booster is authorized, can I get the flu shot at the same time?

The CDC allows us to give multiple vaccines at the same time. That means you can get a flu shot with a COVID booster, with a COVID first dose, with a COVID second dose or a shingles shot. We are able to give them at the same time on the same day. There's no waiting period. At St.Luke's Hospital if one of the vaccines was given in the last 14 days, it is recommended to separate two shots by two weeks before getting the second shot.

Bishop William W. How wrote the text of “For All the Saints” in 1864, for use in the Anglican church liturgy commemorating All Saints Day. It was originally titled “Saints Day Hymn—Cloud of Witnesses—Hebrews 12:1.” The Hebrews passage is Pastor Jameson’s scripture for November 7th.

As you sing “For All the Saints”, recall the various individuals who have especially influenced your life for God. Breathe a prayer of thanks for their memory.

Whitehall-Coplay Hunger Initiative's Community Meals Update

The WCHI is in the process of finalizing meals from October through December and into 2022, but a schedule has not been posted yet. "Drop and Go" meals or inside sit-down meals will be arranged at whatever church or organization provides the meal. Due to the current covid-19 restrictions at church, St. John's is unable to provide meals at this time.

"Operation Santa" – Mitten Tree Project: We are not collecting gifts this year due to some covid restrictions. Instead, **we are encouraging everyone to give a donation to Phoebe Ministries or Valley Youth House or both.** From your funds, gifts will be purchased by the staffs at both locations and delivered to their clients and residents.



 **Phoebe Ministries** – Founded in 1903 and affiliated with the UCC, Phoebe Ministries is an organization specializing in healthcare, housing and support services to **seniors**. It is guided by its mission to provide compassionate care to residents of its community regardless of their ability to pay.

 **Valley Youth House** – It began in 1973 as a single shelter in the Lehigh Valley for homeless young people. Its mission is to help all **youth**, those who have been abused, ran away, or are homeless. Valley Youth House helps them build a healthy and independent future.

Pavilion Update

We are nearing the end of our long journey—completion of the pavilion. And, it is hoped that by the time you read this article, all work and final inspections will have been completed.

While there may be some additional charges for work order changes, it appears that the total we will borrow is about \$104,000. At this point, we have withdrawn about \$39,000 from our \$120,000 Cornerstone Line of Credit and could need an additional \$65,000 from that account. (The major outstanding item, not included above, is a decision on purchase of tables.)

The above numbers are “soft”. Final totals will be available once all work is done.

In the meantime, continued member financial contributions to reduce our Furnace Loan or to the Pavilion Loan (Cornerstone) are very important as we work to lessen our financial obligation.

Shortly, in your mailed envelopes, you will notice a new line item (Pavilion Loan) which we hope will help to more quickly eliminate our debt. It is expected that loan payments on our cash advances from Cornerstone will begin in October or November.

Thank you for your encouragement and on-going financial support throughout this project.

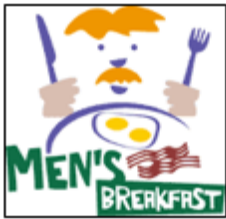
