UPDATE FROM THE SEARCH COMMITTEE

Recently the Search Committee had two second interviews with two separate candidates. Unfortunately, we were all disappointed with the end results of both. At this point, we have no other prospects and we have not received a profile since June 23. An e-mail has been sent to Pastor Bonnie Bates, the conference minister. We hope she can provide us with some insight and direction as to where we go from here.

The committee members questioned themselves as to whether or not we were being too overly selective in reviewing our profiles. After some discussion, we decided this is not the case. The people of St. John's were very clear in answering our questions and surveys as to what they are looking for in a senior pastor. The committee doesn't want to feel they need to select someone who is not a good fit for St. John's only because our interim pastor has left and there is a "timing issue".

There is no timing issue. The Penn Northeast Conference will provide us with temporary spiritual leadership for as long as it's needed and until that person arrives, St. John's has it's own contingency plan in place. We also have excellent laity leadership at St. John's and we work together very well - we all do. There is nothing stopping us from continuing to worship, love and serve - no matter what.

We are sorry we don't have better news for you at this time. Nobody could be more disappointed, discouraged, and disheartened than your search committee. But we are not giving up! Tomorrow is another day and we will continue to press on with whatever resources we have the very minute they are available to us. In the meantime, your prayers, support and encouragement are very much needed and very deeply appreciated.

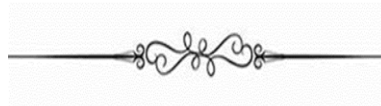

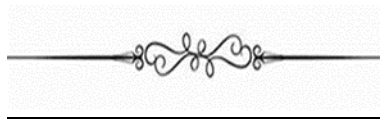

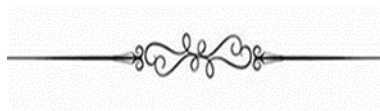


Surfside, Florida Condo Collapse - What You Can Do!

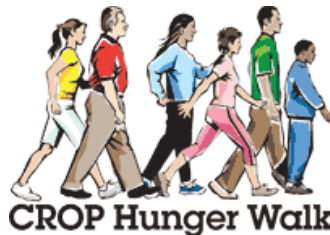

Whitehall-Coplay Hunger Initiative's Community Meals Update



Jean McGonigle, chairperson of the Mission Committee, attended a meeting of the Whitehall-Coplay Hunger Initiative (WCHI) on July 27 to explore options for the restart of the Free Community Meals Program provided by our Faith Based Partners. One of the goals of this meeting was to decide when to begin, with September as a target date. There were many questions from those in attendance and many thoughts of when and where to begin. Because of the Covid restrictions and the status of each faith-based church or organization, it was decided that an additional meeting was needed and would be held on August 24 to continue with discussions about these plans.

Right now, WCHI is looking for guidance from both the PA Dept. of Agriculture (who oversees all food in the state) and from Feeding America (who gives guidance to Second Harvest, a major source of food supplies). WCHI is looking at providing hot meals in “drop and go” take-out containers to start in September and then, eventually, work into having sit-down meals.

Meals are provided the 1st Sunday and 3rd Tuesday of the month from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and guarantees free meals to the first 100 guests. In addition to receiving meals, this can also be a social outing, which provides a sense of community and fellowship for guests as well as for the volunteers who work together to provide these meals. St. John's provided a meal in 2019 and will explore the possibility of doing so in the future.

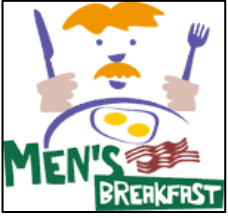


Nut & Fruit Sale
