ONNSFA Providing Essential Services Through Jan. 24, 2021

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. – The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship & Financial Assistance (ONNSFA) will continue to provide essential services through Jan. 24, 2021, in compliance with Executive Order 002-21 issued by President Jonathan Nez and Vice President Myron Lizer on Thursday. The order limits government services to minimize the spread of the coronavirus disease.

All ONNSFA offices will remain closed to the public and are currently operating with minimal staff. There may be extended wait times for phone calls. The ONNSFA staff is continuing to evaluate applications for Spring 2021. The deadline for applications for the Spring 2021 term was Nov. 25, 2020.
