

ONNSFA's Ft. Defiance Agency & Central **Administration Offices Re-Opened After Clearance By** Navajo Nation Office of Environmental Health

The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship & Financial Assistance's Ft. Defiance Agency & Central Administration offices have resumed operations in the Navajo Education Center in Window Rock, Ariz.

The building was closed on Thursday, May 30, 2019, and programs were temporarily re-located as a precaution when it was reported that a Dept. of Diné Education staff member tested positive for hantavirus. The Navajo Environmental Health & Protection Program conducted a field site observation to ensure safety of the worksite. Based upon the report, there is no definitive evidence of possible contact source of infection or rodent activity within the Department of Diné Education facility.
