Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be in Kindergarten or higher
- Must have a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) or higher for the year
- Must race a minimum of 10 races at the Charlotte BMX Track between July 1 and June 30 of the respective year
- USA BMX license must be unexpired as of June 30 of the year
- Must submit Taylor Scholarship Form for the school year just ended by deadline to be considered for the award. The deadline will be determined by our board and will be posted on the Charlotte BMX website and Facebook.

I. <u>Local Participation Component:</u>

A Races:

- 5 points for each Charlotte BMX Local Races during July 1- June 30 of the respective year. Counts class, open, cruiser.
- To obtain a copy of your rider's races email membership@usabmx.com asking for your riders race report from July 1 June 30 of the respective years
 - O This must be submitted with this form is required to receive any points for this component.

B Volunteer Participation:

- Will be awarded as one point for each hour volunteered
- All hours must be signed by a Charlotte BMX Officer
- Activities eligible for points include: registration, corner marshal, track maintenance, scoring, concession stand, staging, gate, mowing, clean ups, etc.
- Volunteer Index Cards are available in registration and they will be stored in there.
- It is your responsibility to see that your points are recorded for volunteering
 - O This must be submitted with this form is required to receive any points for this component.

II. Scholastic Component:

- On a four-point scale multiply the final GPA for the year by 60. *4.0 is the cap. (If the rider has higher than a 4.0 GPA he/she will use 4.0)
 - A. A 4.0 average will generate 240 points (4.0 x 60)
 - B. A 3.5 average will generate 210 points (3.5 x 60)
- If your child is in grades K 5 or Report Cards that are not given a GPA. Please see an official regarding this or contact Charlotte BMX at charlottebmxtrack@yahoo.com
 - O A photocopy of the Final Report Card (for the school year just ending) with the Taylor Scholarship Form is required to receive any points for this component.
