You can call upon your experiences and memories of MHS—a time period, an event, a place, person, and/or artifact to inspire your work. Be creative! Surprise us!

Submissions must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Drawing, Painting, Digital, or 3D will be considered
- Works must be no larger than 18” X 24”
- Canvas, paper, sculpture, and ceramics will be accepted. No paintings on heavy wood, etc.
- No notebook paper (please use unlined paper)
- Still life, landscape, portraits, abstract, and graphic designs are acceptable

We hope to get 100 submissions. Many of the pieces will be displayed around Milton HS. We will have an art show featuring the pieces during our 100th anniversary celebration weekend in the Fall of 2021. We may have a MHS art show with chosen pieces at the Alpharetta Arts Center. AND, one piece will be chosen as the cover art of an Appen Media MHS 100th Anniversary magazine publication that will be published in Fall 2021 and distributed throughout our local area.
