## Ideas to get you started:

- Did a teacher inspire you? Write a thank you note specifically to a teacher or generally to the MHS community.
- Did you keep a diary or journal? Share an entry you wrote about an event, class, activity. You can even add your thoughts about it now, looking back.
- What MHS experience challenged you to leave your comfort zone or sparked passion? What were the benefits and lasting value?
- Who is someone you remember vividly from your days at MHS? Describe why you remember this person.
- What role did sports, music, theatre, arts, academics play in your life at MHS? Reflect on your participation.
- What is/was special about Milton High School? Why is/was Milton a great place to go to school?

Your piece can be creative and/or abstract or anecdotal. It can be serious and dramatic or comical. It must be appropriate for an audience of all ages. All pieces must be your original thoughts and writing. You may include an image or sketch to accompany your piece, but nothing that is copyrighted.

- Faculty/Staff: Affiliation with MHS and years affiliated (for example: English teacher, 1990-2005)
