Qualifying Units

- Rebate is available for a new system installed in an existing home, new addition or new construction that is served by Cairo Public Utility Company.
- All qualifying units, must be purchased new and installed by a professional service provider conforming to all applicable building, local and state codes, and manufacturer specifications between 05/01/20 and 04/30/21.
- The central air conditioner must be a new, residential-sized ($\leq 65,000$ Btu/hr) Central Air Conditioning ducted split system meeting ENERGY STAR efficiency standards.
- The central air conditioner must have a Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER) rating of 15 or greater and an Energy Efficiency Ratio (EER) of 12.5 or greater to qualify for a rebate. The SEER rating as determined by the AHRI will be used to calculate the rebate amount (SEER ratings cannot be rounded up).
- This measure characterizes the installation of a new residential sized ($\leq 65,000$ Btu/hr) Central Air Conditioning ducted split system meeting ENERGY STAR efficiency standards (15 SEER and 12.5 EER).

Rebate Levels

≥ 15 SEER Qualified Residential Central Air Conditioner = \$300.00 rebate

≥ 16 SEER Qualified Residential Central Air Conditioner = \$400.00 rebate

≥ 18 SEER Qualified Residential Central Air Conditioner = \$600.00 rebate
