Motion to open the Commissioner's Meeting for general discussion. Motion seconded.
Meeting came to order at 7:18 pm

Topic 1: Unanticipated Donation

The Village District received an unanticipated donation of \$5,000 from Bob and Fran Bell at the Village District Annual Meeting this year. General discussion.

The commissioners and all in attendance expressed their sincere appreciation for this generous donation.

The commissioners have the authority to accept and expend this donation per the provisions of RSA 31:95-b and as voted at the 2012 Moeckel Pond Village District Annual Meeting.

Motion for the commissioners to accept the donation for general Village District use. Seconded.
Commissioners voted 3-0 to accept the donation.

Topic 2: Poison Ivy Removal

General discussion related to poison ivy on the Village District property at the dam. The poison ivy is spread throughout the rock wall / old mill foundation areas including prime dam viewing area for the public. Dianna Fallon has obtained a quote from a company, Northeast Vegetation and Mosquito Control, to spray to eradicate the poison ivy. Total cost for 2022 would be \$775, which includes a \$500 permit fee and \$275 spray fee which includes two treatments.

There was a general discussion about how long the permit is good for and what the cost of subsequent permitting and applications would be. Dianna will find out.

General discussion among the commissioners. Motion for the commissioners to expend the \$775 for poison ivy removal for 2022. Seconded.
Commissioners voted 3-0 to approve.

Motion to close the budget hearing. Motion seconded.
