LLTS contractor for **DEED**:

Referral received:

- Intake is step one
- Assessment needs planned and hours approved.
- Provided by professionals such as Speech, Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist or ATP.
- MN wide in person Services

Equipment:

- Vocational Rehab given recommendations.
- Assistance with the bids if needed.
- Set up and training for equipment once approved.
- MN wide, in person services.


LLTS Waiver Funding:

- Social model services
- Person has MN Medicaid funding but has attentional needs for services/equipment.
- ATP, or AT professional such as OT, Speech, or PT.
- Assessment and training may occur in the home, work or community setting.

- AT equipment for life skills.
- Equipment not considered Durable Medical equipment or that is denied.
- Needs a bid or bids/approval
- Needs correct code for item that are AT for waiver funding.







Quadstick:




Quad stick set up for computer access mounting from behind the table:




Quad stick set up for computer access mounting off the side:


