MA/State plan equipment funding

State plan covers durable medical equipment (DME)

Equipment must:

- Be prescribed or ordered by a medical provider
- Primarily serve a medical purpose
- Be reusable
- Not be used for people without an injury or disability
- Be appropriate for home use

Durable medical equipment examples:

• Hospital beds, pressure mattresses, lift beds and blankets

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- Mobility aids walkers, scooters, canes, crutches and wheelchairs
- Personal care aids bath chairs, commodes, dressing aids
- Prosthetics and orthotics
- Oxygen concentrators, monitors, ventilators & related supplies
- Kidney machines
