Combined Test Divisions:

***All combined test divisions will consist of one dressage tests and 2 jump rounds.**

1. Poles (Maplegrove Walk/Trot Dressage and poles courses)
2. x-rails (Maplegrove Walk/Trot Dressage and low x-rail courses)
3. Pre-Entry (SOCTA Pre-entry Dressage tests and 2'0" - 2'-3" jumper)
4. Entry(SOCTA Entry Dressage tests and 2'-6 – 2'9" jumper)
5. Pre-Training (SOCTA Pre-training dressage test and 2'-9" to 3'-0" jumper)
6. Training (SOCTA Training Dressage test and 3'-3" jumper)

RULES:

Dressage: all arenas will be 20m x 40m. Whips will be allowed. Rider dress will not be formal, but horses need to neat and clean. Saddle pads should be white. Breeches should be white or light tan and nicely fitted collared shirt or jacket in a dark contrasting color. No schooling coloured pads please for dressage. Riders are to be neat and clean with no loose clothing or hoodies. Light coloured breeches and a fitted jacket, vest or sweater would be appropriate depending on weather conditions. Full show dress is always welcome for dressage phase.

Jumper: White square jumper pads or fitted numnahs are preferred, however clean colored pads will be allowed.

Round 1 will be straight forward with at least half the jumps 3" lower than maximum for the level.
Round 2 will be a little more technical with most of the jumps at maximum height for the level.

Scoring:

Dressage test percentage will be converted to a penalty score. Eg: 65% dressage test will receive 35penalty points(pp). Penalties incurred for jumper phases will be added and lowest score will be the winner. An elimination in any of the phases will mean and final score of E for the day. Any eliminated riders in dressage or round 1 of jumping will be allowed to finish their jump rounds. To keep things interesting and encourage better riding at the lower levels, audible touches of poles in the poles and x-rail divisions will be faulted as knock downs: 4pp each.. Rounds will not be timed for x-rails and poles.

Rosettes to 6th place for all divisions
