

Trivia Rules:

Respectful Gameplay: Please refrain from yelling out answers, whether correct or incorrect, as it disrupts the game and can bother other players.

Team Formation: Gather your brainiest friends or find a random group to join; it doesn't matter who they are. Each team should consist of 4-6 players. Larger groups will need to split into multiple teams.

No Outside Devices: Cell phones, tablets, etc. are prohibited. Teams caught using electronic devices will be ineligible for prizes. If you need to use your phone in the middle of a trivia round, you won't be allowed to return to the table until the next round starts.

No Mid-Round Member Replacements : Once a trivia round has started, teams cannot replace members until the beginning of the next round.

Respect Judges' Decisions: Our researched answers are final. Disputes will not alter the judges' decisions.

Have Fun!: Choose a witty team name and add it to the top of your answer sheets. There will be 6 rounds, each comprising 10 questions. The team with the most points after 6 rounds wins. Approximately 1 minute per question will be allotted for you to come up with an answer. If there's a tie at the end of the night, we'll ask a tie-breaking question to determine the winner.

Breaks: There will be 2 breaks - 1 after the 2nd round and 1 after the 4th round.

Scoring: At the end of each round, teams will pass their answer sheets to a neighboring team to score. Make sure the person in charge of your answer sheet writes legibly. Each question is worth one point unless otherwise specified.
