Use this practice sheet to spark your imagination and begin your story journey.

Prompt: The Door in the Tree

Imagine you discover a tiny, hidden door in the trunk of a giant tree. It's just big enough for you to open... but what's waiting on the other side?

Brainstorming Questions

- What does the tree look like? (Is it glowing? Ancient? Covered in vines?)
- What kind of door is it? (Wooden? Metal? Carved with symbols?)
- Is there a key or secret way to open it?
- What is the first thing you see when the door opens?
- Who or what lives beyond the door?

Story Starter

Here's a few sentence-starters to help you begin if you need a little push:

"As my fingers brushed the ancient bark, a soft click echoed—and a tiny door swung open, revealing..."

"When I opened the door hidden inside the tree, I couldn't believe what I saw..."

"Behind the door in the tree, there was something magical waiting for me..."

- Use your five senses! What do you hear, smell, feel, and see?
- Don't be afraid to dream big—anything can exist beyond that door!
- Let your imagination climb as high as the tallest branches! **
