Stanza 6:

- Line 1: [Sentence using Word 2]

- Line 5: [Sentence using Word 3]
- Line 6: [Sentence using Word 1]

Envoi (Final Three Lines):

- Line 1: [Sentence incorporating Word 2, and Word 5]
- Line 2: [Sentence incorporating Word 4, and Word 3]
- Line 3: [Sentence incorporating Word 6, and Word 1]

Key points to remember:

- Each stanza should end with one of your six chosen words, following the pattern throughout the poem.
- The order of the end words rotates in each stanza.
- The final "Envoi" stanza incorporates all six words in a concluding manner.
- You can adjust the sentence structure and imagery to fit your theme and style.
- Be creative in how you use the repeated words to build meaning within your poem.
- Envoi flexibility: While all six end-words must appear in the envoi, the order in which they appear can be varied, allowing for different interpretations and emphasis on certain words or themes.
- Examples of Variations: Some poets might choose to group related words together, while others might interweave them to create a sense of resolution or contrast.
