Fall sports are finishing up. The next game will be home on 11/27 against AC Flora.

Winter sports are starting up. Wrestlers have been practicing for one week and basketball for two weeks. Administration Report

Treasurer Report

Amy Faulkenberry, Treasurer, was not able to be present due to other commitments. No report is submitted. There has been a recent deposit of \$28,007.89 which includes concessions, a \$7,000.00 grant from Coca Cola Bottling and \$34.00 for returning gas. The golf cart has been repaired (new seats, tires, light and rekeyed) at a cost of about \$1,300.00. The golf cart is very helpful in running concession during football. The insurance premium has been paid.

Committee Reports

Concessions

We provided concessions for football and volleyball. The biggest change was that there was no grilled food which has impacted sales. We implemented a card reader and cash apps which have received positive feedback and may have promoted sales.

We had apparel for sale at the football games and are looking to expand it to other events.

We are looking at a mid-year transfer of funds to the Athletic Department to help relieve some of the financial burden for spring sports.

A schedule for concessions is going out for the winter sports. We have guidelines for Covid-19 compliance which were discussed such as the lower doors being shut and fans walking down to the seats. There will not be any fans on the floor and it will be a similar set up to volleyball. Concessions may also be set up on the balcony level due to Covid-19 to assist with social distancing. School Store

There will be a soft opening on 12/2 and there will also be an ability to purchase apparel. It will be set up outside the cafeteria.
