

JUNE 2026 REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

Chairman **Ledebuhr** called the June 4, 2026 Money Creek Town Board Meeting to order at 6:00PM. Other board members present included Supervisors **Feine**, and Treasurer **Deboer** and Clerk **Florin**. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Chairman **Ledebuhr** called for the reading of the Secretary's Report, which the Clerk read aloud. Supervisor **Feine** motioned to approve the Secretary's Report as read. This motion was seconded by Chairman **Ledebuhr**. Chairman **Ledebuhr** called for a vote which was unanimous in favor of approval.

Chairman **Ledebuhr** called for the reading of the Treasurer's Report. Treasurer **Deboer** reported the following balances ending **May 31, 2026**:

Supervisor **Feine** motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report as read. This motion was seconded by Chairman **Ledebuhr**. Chairman **Ledebuhr** called for a vote which was unanimous in favor of approval.

Supervisor **Feine** made a motion to pay the bills. This motion was seconded by Chairman **Ledebuhr**. Chairman **Ledebuhr** called for a vote which was unanimous in favor of approval.

Corey Benson provided the road rock update; he explained that he had helped Bruening by staking/marketing the start/stop sections of road that needed rock. He will be working to grade roads now that we are getting rain today.

Chairman **Ledebuhr** mentioned that Steve Hoskins is coming tomorrow to resolve the electrical issue that is causing the cemetery water pump to not work. This is a lagging issue since the vehicle crashed into the town hall.

Mrs. Danielson was in attendance and questioned why the landowners involved with the recent alleyway vacation were changed \$600 instead of \$500. Mrs. Danielson read a prepared statement challenging the results of the recent alleyway vacation by the town board. Additionally, Mrs. Danielson had some issues with her neighbor again and requested that the board contact the Houston County sheriff's office. Paul responded that he would talk to Swedberg. Mr. Danielson also commented about how the dispute started. Chairman **Ledebuhr** explained that he would contact the township attorney to attend the next meeting to answer these specific legal issues and questions. Brian Forsythe was also on hand and commented that he would like to get along with his neighbors.

The supervisors reviewed the building permit from Laurie Ann Omodt-Tebrake. Supervisor Feine motioned to approve the building permit. Seconded by Chairman Ledebuhr. Chairman Ledebuhr called for a vote which was unanimous in favor of approval.

Treasurer **Deboer** made a recommendation to reduce any risk of the Debit cards used by the town boards. Her suggestion would be to put a small amount of money into a separate checking account used by the debit cards. This would reduce the risk. Supervisor **Feine** motioned to set up a separate checking account for this purpose. Chairman **Ledebuhr** seconded the motion. Chairman Ledebuhr called for a vote which was unanimous in favor of approval.

Joan Redig was on hand and noted that it's been 10 years since the park trees were planted and they are still thriving. She also commended Corey on doing a great job on the roads.

Corey asked if the chloride was going to be coming soon. Paul noted that other townships use magnesium chloride instead of calcium chloride. It would be \$1.75 per gallon vs. \$1.89 per gallon we paid HCDOT last season. The supervisors also voiced some safety and wasted product issues with the driver

and equipment that the county provided last year; Chairman **Ledebuhr** is looking at having another contractor do magnesium chloride. Supervisor **Feine** made a motion to approve using Dustbusters Dust Control out of West Union Iowa. This motion was seconded by Chairman **Ledebuhr**. Chairman **Ledebuhr** called for a vote which was unanimous in favor of approval.

Clerk Florin read an email survey from Houston County Public Health Department. They are developing a project called "Age Friendly Houston County" and are requesting suggestions that might make the county more age-friendly – such as more transportation options, as an example provided by the County. Brian Forsythe mentioned that reducing noise issues in the township might be a suggestion; such as loud side-by-sides driving through town at top speeds.

Chairman **Ledebuhr** mentioned that Rich Botcher is still spraying for the county, so it will be some time before he can get to our township needs.

The board discussed options for setting up wi-fi locks that are all keyed the same, for all the town hall doors.

Chairman **Ledebuhr** commented that no progress has been made yet on the office chairs for the town board.

Chairman **Ledebuhr** explained that Phil Neisen turned in 12 gophers and 1 woodchuck – Clerk Florin to issue payment at the July meeting.

Following up from last meeting, Chairman **Ledebuhr** did some research on new graders; he explained some of the price ranges from the various heavy equipment manufacturers and used equipment sellers. He also looked into potential leasing options that looked reasonable.

With no additional business to conduct, Supervisor **Feine** motioned to adjourn the June Town Board Meeting. This motion was seconded by Chairman **Ledebuhr**. Chairman **Ledebuhr** called for a vote which was unanimous in favor of adjournment, and the meeting adjourned at 7:17pm.
