Program Policies

Attendance	Students are required to attend all scheduled class meetings, maintain weekly engagement through the Learning Management System (LMS), and communicate regularly with their assigned instructor or the Academy. Failure to meet these requirements — including attendance below 70%, missing more than three live classes without viewing recorded sessions, or lack of contact for three consecutive weeks — may result in academic dismissal without refund.
Standards	Students whose academic average drops below 70% will be placed on academic probation. We will help the student develop a clear action plan with specific goals and deadlines. If the student is unsuccessful in meeting those goals and target dates, the student will be subject to academic dismissal with no refund.
Entrance	All applicants must be 18 years of age. A high school diploma or GED equivalent is also required for most employment opportunities but is not required to take or start the training. No criminal record — please contact the school for more information should you have any prior record.
Refund	1. You may terminate the Enrollment Agreement at any time by informing the school in writing (not the instructor). Termination is effective upon receipt of written notice. Refund is based on the notification week corresponding to your start date. 2. If you terminate before you commence training, you will receive a refund of the money paid to the school, minus \$500 for the course books and the \$300.00 non-refundable application fee. The total subtracted from the refund will be \$800.00. 3. If you terminate within the first 3 weeks, you will receive a prorated refund equal to the unused portion of monies received from your last day of attendance, or week corresponding with your course assignments, less the application fee of \$300.00 and the book fee of \$500.00. If you terminate any time after week 3, there will be no refund. If you are on a payment plan, the balance will be effective as of drop date, 30 days to pay in full or sent to collections.
