The EKG Technician program prepares students to perform cardiac monitoring, acquire 12-lead EKGs, identify arrhythmias, and assist during stress testing. Upon completion, students sit for the NHA Certified EKG Technician (CET) national certification exam.

What You Will Be Able to Do

1 Perform 12-lead EKG acquisition and correctly apply electrodes and leads	5 Recognize signs of cardiopulmonary compromise and respond appropriately
2 Identify and resolve artifacts (wandering baseline, somatic tremor, AC interference)	6 Prepare patients and equipment for stress testing, telemetry, and ambulatory monitoring
3 Calculate heart rate and determine heart rhythm from EKG tracings	7 Maintain EKG equipment and verify machine settings for accurate tracing
4 Identify arrhythmias, heart blocks, pacemaker spikes, and life-threatening cardiac events	8 Document EKG results accurately in electronic health records (EHR/EMR)

Graduates of this program are eligible to sit for the NHA Certified EKG Technician (CET) national certification exam. The median annual wage for cardiovascular technologists and technicians was \$67,260 in May 2024, with 11% job growth projected through 2033 — much faster than the average for all occupations.
