

## Actual 2019-20 Senior Living Property “A” Jazz Concert Season Announcement

**The Property has 440 residents including 240 Contributing Patrons supplemented by 10 Concert Sponsors and is in its Sixth Season**

We are pleased to announce a program of eight jazz concerts for the 2019-20 season. The artistic objective is to present concerts at the level of the finest venues in the area.

The season will begin in **October** with “**A Jazz Interpretation of the Beatles**” performed by a local 19-piece **Jazz Orchestra**. This event mirrors the opening of the 2018-19 season at which the Stan Kenton Legacy Orchestra performed.

In **November** the distinguished vocalist **Mary Stallings**, whose recent CD went to the top of the jazz charts, will perform with her Trio. Mary performed on the Jazz Cruise in 2018 to accolades. She will also perform at a local club during her tour. This booking is in cooperation with the local jazz club.

The multi-instrumentalist and truly funny guy, **Ken Peplowski** will perform with the **Katie Thiroux Trio in Dec.** Ken is artistic director of the Sarasota Florida and the Newport Beach California jazz parties, doubling on reeds as well. Katie Thiroux leads her own Trio and sings in addition to playing bass. A co-operative booking.

The show entitled “**Best of West Coast Jazz Vocalists**” comes in **January** in the person of **James Torme**, the talented vocalist and son of Mel. Music critics have noted James’ impressive skills. He brings the music not only of his dad but Nat King Cole, Ella Fitzgerald, Anita O’Day and others from the fifties and sixties, popular in our day.

It's hard to find a musical group that has been performing continually for over 70 years but that's exactly what we have in **February** with **The Four Freshmen**. The group's popularity began when many of us were in high school and continues with an International Society of Fans. We will hear songs from the day as well as new offerings.

Heralded as one of the premiere jazz pianists and composers of her generation, the amazing **Renee Rosnes Group** appears in **February**. Renee boasts multiple CDs and brings a group of outstanding sidemen. Another co-operative booking.

It's hard to find someone who has succeeded as an actor, a composer, a singer and a pianist. Those are the talents that will be on display when **Ann Hampton Callaway** appears in **March**. She is a Tony-nominated actress for her work on Broadway, has 25 CD recordings, and is a composer, including composing for Barbra Streisand. She sings “**The Barbra Streisand Song Book and More**”, accompanying herself on piano.

The season ends with an international flair as the **Harold Lopez Nussa Quartet** performs Cuban jazz in **April**. Harold is a winner of the Montreux Jazz Piano Award and brings his group from the heart of Havana’s Jazz District as part of a 38-city US tour. He will be performing at a local performing arts venue during his appearance here.
