- 1. New members pay \$225.00. After which renewing members pay \$100.00 in annual dues. Annual dues are due November 1st of each year and are considered late after January 31st.
- 2. New members joining AMPS after September 1, pay \$225.00. Covering the following year and receive a paid-up status for any days remaining in the current year in which they join
- 3. AMPS Family Plan waves youth membership under 19 years of age where parent, grandparent or legal guardian is an AMPS paid member in good standing. Youth AMPS members must have a Youth Membership from the AMA and complete a required separate AMPS application form.
- 4. Youth membership is available to any current youth AMA member under the age of 19 for \$10.00 annual dues. A legal guardian must be with youth member while flying at the AMPS facility until 16 years of age for supervision. A completed AMPS application form is required

If you are considering becoming an R/C pilot or you are a seasoned pilot please contact one of our flight instructors for free club flight lessons or a required check-out ride with club orientation prior to flying.
