Jeremiah 29:11 is a verse that many Christians know by heart, or have at least heard quoted. "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans for hope and a future." Aside from this verse, the context of Jeremiah may not be as familiar. Jeremiah has often been described as a weeping prophet, however, the real testimony of his ministry is that he persevered despite the hardships he encountered.
