### December 1st "A Guiding Light"

The Wise Men followed the star through the night sky to reach the Christ Child. Upon reaching their destination, they bowed down and worshipped Jesus. ### December 8th "A Heavy Load"

As they followed the star to the manger, the Wise Men carried gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. These gifts were provided as a way to show honor to Jesus. ## Advent

The word **Advent** means "coming" or "arrival." The Advent wreath is a circular evergreen wreath. It has four candles in the wreath and a candle in the center. The circle of the wreath is symbolic of eternity. The greenery of the wreath is symbolic of the hope we have in God and of eternal life. The light of the candles reminds us that Jesus is the light of the world and that we are called to be a light of God's grace to others. Advent provides us with the opportunity to

- Look back at what God has promised and fulfilled.
- Look forward to the promises yet to be fulfilled, but with the faith that what God has accomplished in the past, God will fulfill in His promises in the future.
- We celebrate: Love, Joy, Peace and Hope
- Our response to Advent should be: 2 Peter 3:8-13
- We come to believe that God is still at work in heaven and that his work directly impacts what is happening on earth.
- We pray and live in that his will would be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matthew 6:10)


