1. Introduction

2. Important Medical Privacy Notice (HIPAA)

A. Personal Information

We may collect:

- Email address
- Phone number
- Date of birth (if submitted)
- Billing information
- Mailing address

B. Health-Related Information

If submitted through forms (e.g., intake, contact forms):

- Medical history

- Medications
- Symptoms or concerns

Important: Submission through website forms may not be fully secure. Patients are encouraged to use our secure patient portal.

C. Automatically Collected Information

- IP address
- Browser type
- Device type
- Pages visited
- Cookies and tracking data

4. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Provide and manage services
- Respond to inquiries
- Schedule appointments
- Process payments and memberships
- Improve our website and services
- Send updates, reminders, or marketing (if consented)

5. How We Share Information

We do **not** sell your personal information.

We may share your information with:

A. Healthcare & Business Operations

- Laboratories (e.g., Quest Diagnostics, Labcorp)
- Pharmacies (including compounding pharmacies)
- Payment processors (e.g., Stripe)
- Electronic Health Record systems (e.g., Hint Health)

B. Legal Requirements

We may disclose information if required by:

- Texas law
- Federal law
- Court order or subpoena

6. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We may use cookies and similar tracking technologies to:

- Improve website performance
- Analyze user behavior
- Customize user experience

You can disable cookies in your browser settings.

7. Data Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect your information.

However:

- No system is 100% secure
- Email and website forms are not guaranteed secure

8. Your Rights (Texas & U.S.)

You have the right to:

For medical records, HIPAA rights apply separately.
