Dear Friends,

The advice of theologian Karl Barth was that we preach and teach with a bible in one hand and a newspaper in the other. He believed the relevancy of our preaching and teaching is directly related to the news of the day.

In a large sister church in Mansfield Ohio a colleague of mine started a discussion group with Barth's idea in mind, The group was asked to bring a newspaper article to the table each week, where the questions or discussions it encouraged would celebrate or disregard the Gospel.

I visited that church as a guest preached and visited the group of about 20 men and women. What a stimulating discussion! People were engaged in discussing how to relate the Gospel to the news.
