From My Heart to Yours...

Dear Friends,

My two oldest brothers, Karl and Christian, were chefs. As young boys they started as kitchen help in restaurants here on Nantucket. Years later they ended their careers as Executive Chefs. Both of them also had catering businesses on the side. I worked for one of them one summer. (You have heard the wisdom of "don't ever work for your relatives?"). To say the least, it was hard labor!

What happened as a result of that experience, however, was the ability to secure a job during my last year of high school with a Jewish caterer, who did bat and bar mitzvas, where I learned a great deal more about preparing for a banquet. That was followed by a year as the "cook and bottle washer 'at a local café during college. That was followed by attendance at hundreds of wedding and funeral receptions.

You learn a lot working these jobs, and attending these events. I don't remember any which lacked guests! The parable we are reading this morning, has several layers to it, as all of Jesus' parables do. It is about being prepared for guests, serving the "public," persistence, doing things well, not ceasing to open one's doors to guests, ie. being invitational. The banquet to which we are inviting people is life-changing.
