Dear Friends.

We have our confirmands with us in worship this morning. You'll see them again, I'm sure. Together, we are getting into the Bible. We want them to see it as the Good Book. And while is it not a novel, it is like a novel in that there is nothing it does not attempt to speak to, and not much it fails to get away with.

We might actually say that it is not a book at all, but a library of sixty-six books written over centuries by heaven knows whom, and for many divergent purposes, and many points of view. Yet, in some sense it manages to be one book. Something holds it together.

The opening chapters of Genesis set the stage for everything that follows, "In the beginning God CREATED. "Creation is one of the great themes of the Good Book. More than almost anything else, God makes things. God makes the world in all its splendor, and the book of Psalms never stops stammering about their wonder of it all.

Among all of those things made, God made a people, Israel. To be a blessing to all people. There is a single plot to the good book – God creates the world. The world gets lost. God seeks to restore the world to the glory for which God created it. This means that this Good Book is about you and me, whom God made and lost and still continually seeks. The book, in all its goodness, is that which holds us together.

During these weeks of confirmation, at every opportunity you might have to do so, bless our confirmands. There is yet much for them to learn.
