Leader: Let the message of Christ dwell among us richly as we teach one another with all wisdom


Congregation: Through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, let us sing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

Now concerning the times and the seasons, brothers and sisters, you do not need to have anything written to you. For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so

that whether we are awake or asleep we may live with him. Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing.


Matthew 25:30

Then the one who had received the one talent also came forward, saying, 'Master, I knew that you were a harsh man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you did not scatter seed; so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here you have what is yours.' But his master replied, 'You wicked and lazy slave! You knew, did you, that I reap where I did not sow, and gather where I did not scatter? Then you ought to have invested my money with the bankers, and on my return I would have received what was my own with interest. So take the talent from him,

and give it to the one with the ten talents. For to all those who have, more will be given, and they will have an abundance; but from those who have nothing, even what they have will be taken away. As for this worthless slave, throw him into the outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

From My Heart To Yours...

Dear Friends,

Sir Michael Costa, a celebrated conductor, was holding a rehearsal. As the mighty chorus rang out, accompanied by scores of instruments, the piccolo player--a little pint-sized flute --thinking perhaps that his contribution would not be missed amid so much music, stopped playing. Suddenly, the Costa stopped the music and shouted out, "Where is the piccolo?" Like all conductors, Costa had an ear for every sound that contributed to the orchestra. To him there are no insignificant instruments in an orchestra. Sometimes the smallest and seemingly least important one can make the greatest contribution and even if it doesn't seem to make that big a difference to the audience at large, it does to the conductor.

In a Church, especially a church like ours, the players and the instruments are diverse—different sizes, different shapes, different notes, different roles to play. But like the piccolo player in Sir Michael's orchestra, there are days when one of you might think that your contribution is not significant. And so you quit playing. Stop doing that which we are gifted to do. We drop out. I just have to believe I'm talking to some piccolo players this morning, who have dropped out of the orchestra, for whatever reasons: pain, exhaustion, fear? Convinced that your contribution doesn't mean much in the larger scale of things. We have buried our talent in the ground.

For all piccolos who are afraid, or at least aren't playing, Jesus has something to say to you in this parable we are reading this morning.
