Code of Conduct

Members of the Grand Junction Senior Recreation Center shall govern themselves by the following *Code of Contact:*

- 1. Members shall treat others with courtesy and respect.
- Members shall not use profanity, engage in the use of derogatory comments or use language that is abusive, threatening, loud, insulting or harassing.
- 3. Members shall not fight, encourage others to fight, bully or engage in disruptive behavior.
- 4. Members shall not deface or damage Center property.
- 5. Members shall not remove any property from the Center without the permission from the Board.
- 6. Members shall not steal.
- 7. Members shall not bring alcohol, illegal drugs or weapons to the Center.
- 8. Members shall NOT engage in solicitation within the Center.
- 9. Members shall not make unwelcomed sexual advances, requests for sexual favors and other verbal, physical or visual conduct of a sexual nature.
- 10. There is absolutely no saving of seats or player spaces at any activity.
- 11. Members of Grand Junction Senior Recreation Center must be able to care for themselves independently while participating in Center activities.
- 12. Proper personal hygiene is expected from all members. Please refrain from using strong scents or perfumes.
- 13. The Center is not responsible for the security, damage or theft of any personal belongings or misplaced items within the Center or on its grounds.
- 14. The Center is a family. We do NOT support individualized programs that do NOT include all members.
- 15. Members must govern themselves by the Center's Code of Conduct.

Any infraction to the above Code of Conduct may be grounds for a verbal or written warning, suspension or expulsion from the Grand Junction Senior Recreation Center with all rights and privileges thereof.
